Den 16: 10:40 – 10:50am

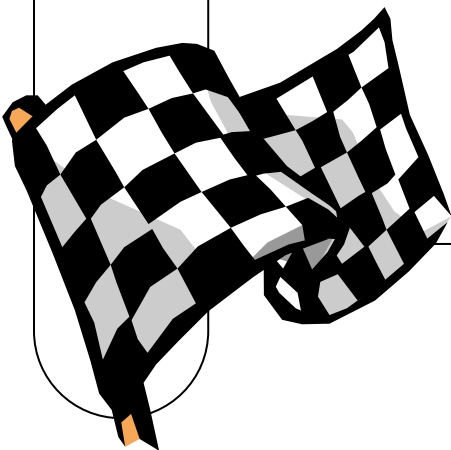
Dens 12 & 13: 10:50 – 11:00am
